I usually have about 5-6 groups of students, depending on class size. I meet with my below grade level reading groups four days a week. My on-grade level and above-grade level groups meet with me 2-3 days a week. When I meet with my guided reading groups, we read books, magazines, or passages depending on the strategy/skill we are focusing on.

I was used to doing almost all of my reading instruction WHOLE CLASS, but my school uses a guided reading model all the way up to 5th grade. I definitely had to rethink my reading block! I had done centers in the past, but wanted a really clear way to maximize the time and make the transitions clear for the students.

The easiest way to teach a strategy group is to have the students bring their independent reading books to the group. This cuts out a lot of the planning time. I used to spend hours gathering materials for my guided reading groups. Now, if the strategy can be found in most books, I just have the students bring their books to group.

Time each guided reading session, keeping it short for younger students in primary grades. Keep guided reading sessions at 15 to 20 minutes each for reading groups in the second grade. Limit guided reading sessions for Kindergarteners and first graders to 15 minutes.
