### What it is it? Mental Status Exam - University of Washington

Overview. A mental status examination, just like a physical examination, is an intrusion on the patient's rights and should not be conducted against the patient's will. Before a physician performs a mental status examination, s/he must explain the procedure to the patient and ensure the patient understands that exam results will be documented.

### Mental Status Exam - Therapist Aid

•The mental status examination describes the sum total of the examiner's observations and impressions of the psychiatric patient at the time of the interview. •Whereas the patient's history remains stable, the patient's mental status can change from day to day or hour to hour.

### Understanding the Mental Status Examination

The mental status examination is a core skill of qualified (mental) health personnel. It is a key part of the initial psychiatric assessment in an outpatient or psychiatric hospital setting. It is a systematic collection of data based on observation of the patient's behavior while the patient is in the clinician's view during the interview.
